

Code of Conduct

All persons belonging to the BRIDGE FET Edu Centre family believe in respecting and implanting the following values:

- Aim** The parents, educators and students aim at working together to promote the positive development of each student. **When we invite parents to parent-educator meetings, attendance is expected.**
- Discrimination** NO discrimination will take place with regards to race or gender as we are all precious to our Heavenly Father, Jesus Christ.
- Respect** We will respect one another, our educators and property. We will respect one another's unique gifts and talents and refrain from belittling or humiliating one another. We will address one another with respect and learn to submit to authority at home and at the Educational Centre.
- Discipline** We will adhere to the system of discipline to which the Educational Centre subscribes. We accept that learning can only flourish in an atmosphere of order and discipline. We understand that parents and educators form a united front and will always try to act in the student's best interest. A child who knows that he / she will be held accountable for his / her actions (both good and bad) will experience character development.

 - We will practice self-discipline as individuals and in a group.
 - We will always give one another a fair hearing and calmly listen to all sides of a conflict.
 - We will report any foul play (unfair/violent/dishonest behaviour) to an adult as soon as it happens.
 - We will not solve our problems with our fists or with impure language.
 - We will let adults guide us in finding solutions.
 - We will not disrupt lessons and so prevent another student from making progress.
 - We will do our best to obey all the Centre's rules.
 - We will be tidy with our person and work.
 - We will maintain standards of hygiene.
 - We will be polite to visitors.
 - We will think of kind acts to do to / for others.
 - We will not litter or vandalize (break other's property)
 - We will not steal.
 - We will not bully.
 - We will not cheat.
 - We will obey rules pertaining to safety.
 - We will not enter out of bounds areas.
 - We will come to the Centre on time.
 - We will respect our educators.
 - We will treat God and the Bible with respect.

Tattoos	Strictly forbidden for girls and boys.
Strong Learning Ethic	We will strive to develop a strong learning and work ethic. We will strive to be productive daily. A Safe and Secure Centre	The Educational Centre must be safe for us - physically, mentally, spiritually, and emotionally. Christian Values	Each day begins with devotion. Prayer is an integral part of our Educational Centre’s ethos. Under no circumstances will blasphemy (saying the Lord’s name in vain) be permitted. We will strive to do everything to the glory of the God of the Bible.
