Please take note of the following conditions that must be met for the application process to be successful:

1. Fully complete and return the Application Form with required supporting documents.

Supporting Documents:

- ID document for both parents
 - Student's birth certificate / ID document
 - Utility bill (Address of account holder / parents / guardian).
 - Legal documentation required to indicate student living with guardian/s and not parents
2. Successful ITC Check.
 3. Within 7 days of receiving correspondence from the Educational Centre of a successful application an invoice will be issued to pay the non-refundable registration fee of R 4,750.00.

Dear Prospective Parent / Guardian,

We would like to thank you for considering **BRIDGE FET Edu Centre** as an Educational Facility for your child.

All students enter BRIDGE FET Edu Centre on a 1-year (3 months) trial / probation period. The Educational Centre reserves the right to terminate a student's placement if the principal feels that a student is not benefiting from the educational system offered by **BRIDGE FET Edu Centre**.

We aim at providing quality education.

Bridge FET Edu Centre offers the home school student full-time, face-to-face tutoring using the GED Curriculum.

Bridge Edu Centre aims to provide quality teaching in a stimulating, nurturing, and safe learning environment. We have a maximum of 10 students in each class.

We cannot guarantee the success of any student who DOES NOT give their full co-operation.

- **Enrolment/Registration:** On formal acceptance into our Educational Facility, a once-off non-refundable registration fee of R 4,750 must be paid to **BRIDGE FET Edu Centre** strictly within 7 days after receiving an acceptance email along with an invoice.
- Enrolment / re-registration fees will be forfeited if the student is enrolled but does not show up.
- On completion of this form, the parent/s / guardian/s take full responsibility for the payment of educational fees.
- The completion of this application serves as evidence that the parent / guardian understands that the educational fees should be paid monthly **IN ADVANCE by the 3rd day of each month**. 2% Interest per month will be charged on all outstanding fees.
- Should the annual fee be paid in full, by 31 January 2024, a 5% discount will apply on the full annual amount. Should the child leave the Educational Facility prior to the completion of the 12-month period, the discount applied for the previous months will be forfeited, and the full monthly fee will apply retrospectively, and the balance refunded to the parent over a three-month period.
- **Application forms do not automatically guarantee acceptance.** We will notify you formally once a final decision has been made by management.
- Non-payment of educational fees will result in your child not receiving further tuition until your account is up to date. **BRIDGE FET Edu Centre** is an independent and private tutoring centre. We rely on educational fees to be paid in advance for the smooth running of the facility.
- **Payment of your monthly account cannot be made subject to a third party. i.e. SARS pay-out, trust-fund or any other entity. The Account Holder remains liable for monthly payments until a third party pay on their behalf.**

The Fee Structure for 2024:

Registration fee: R 4,750.00 (GED Curriculum + Bridge Edu Centre)

Payment Options:

- OPTION 1: Lump sum (R 60,000.00)
Qualify for a 5% discount should the full annual fee be paid by 31 January 2024.
- OPTION 2: 12 Instalments (R 5,000 per month)
Payable in advance by no later than the 3rd of each month.
- OPTION 3: 10 Instalments (R 6,000 per month)
Payable in advance by no later than the 3rd of each month.
